

Troubleshooting Guide XLR8/XLR8 Plus





Leak Alert



Step 1 Select appropriate size dressing kit for wound. Kit contains foam, port pad, and 2 drapes. (Small kit has 1 drape only.)



Step 2 Clean the wound according to protocol. Protect wound edges with drape.



Step 3 Cut foam to fit accurately in wound bed. Avoid overlapping onto intact skin. Avoid cutting foam over wound. Avoid over-packing, as this will inhibit filtration of drainage.



Step 4 Cover foam with drape by separating bottom layers 1 and 2 to expose the adhesive drape. Position and place drape over foam. Remove stabilization layers 1 and 2, then top with layer 3. Remove white ruler tab.

Canis Full Alert



Cut a hole in drape the approximate size of a quarter. Remove paper backing 1 from bottom of the Port Pad. Position Port Pad opening over the hole that was created. Remove backing 2 from the top of Port Pad. Flip handler tabs over on each side and peel down to remove.



Step 6 Select canister size and attach to the back of the pump. Connect the port pad to the canister by securing the purple luer lock.



Step 7 Initiate therapy by pressing the universal on/off button . Adjust pressure as prescribed using the up/down arrows.

Step 8 A secure seal is identified when the foam draws down and the target pressure is reached.

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Low Batte Alert

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Critical **Battery** Alert



The unit has detected the battery charge is critically low. The alert on the unit cannot be silenced. The OFF button will not function until unit is plugged in. The message on the screen will read: ALERT: CRITICAL BATTERY, ONLY 2% OF THE CHARGE LEFT ON THE BATTERY, PLUG UNIT INTO ELECTRICAL OUTLET.

Immediately plug power cord into side of pump and electrical outlet to allow pump to recharge. It will take 3 hours for the pump to completely recharge. When recharging, ensure the green power cord icon (upper right-hand corner) illuminates. This will confirm the wall outlet has power.



Alert Icons

XLR8/XLR8 Plus



BLOCKAGE ALERT

Check for a blockage between the wound dressing and the canister.



CANISTER FULL ALERT

Change the canister.



LEAK ALERT

Check for a leak in the dressing or the canister.



LOW BATTERY ALERT

Plug unit in when this alert sounds. 20% power remains on the battery.



CRITICAL BATTERY ALERT

Immediately plug unit in when alert sounds. Unit will shut down in less than 2 minutes. Alert cannot be silenced until power cord is plugged into electrical outlet.

Alert Sounds: What to Do?

- 1. Press Menu/Select to silence.
- 2. Identify alert type.
- 3. Address the issue.
- 4. Green check mark indicates issue resolved.
